#### **1. Introduction**

Keolis Amey Docklands 2025 Limited (“KAD”, “we, “our”) uses cookies on its website. This Cookies Notice explains more about cookies and why we use them. It also explains how you can control and opt out of receiving them.

This policy should be read together with our Privacy Notice which sets out how and why we collect, store, use and share personal information generally, as well as your rights in relation to your personal information and details of how to contact us and supervisory authorities if you have a complaint.

We update this Cookies Notice from time to time in response to changes in applicable laws and regulations, changes to our processing practices and to products and services we offer. #### **2. About Cookies**

A cookie is a small text file which may be downloaded to your device when you visit our website. We use cookies to allow our website to function correctly, remember your preferences and to track visitors to our website.

##### **Why does our website use cookies?**

To improve your experience and to tailor your marketing.

In common with many other website operators, we use cookies to enrich your experience of using the website by allowing us to tailor what you see to what we have learned about your preferences during your visits to the site

The cookies we use on our website fall into the following categories:

##### **Strictly necessary cookies**

Some cookies are required for the successful operation of our website, the details of which appear in section 3 below. These are for the basic functioning of our website.

##### **Statistics or Analytics Cookies**

We use cookies to collect information about the use of our website by visitors such as the pages they visit most often, how they arrived at our website and associated information. These do not collect any directly identifiable personal information about visitors. We use these cookies to learn more about how our website is used to identify problems and areas for improvement.

### **Functionality Cookies**

Functionality cookies remember the choices you make when you visit our website. This includes, for example, your consent to the use of cookies on our website.

### **Marketing or Targeting Cookies**

These are cookies placed by third parties on our website which record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. They use this information for advertising purposes.

By continuing to use our website without choosing to delete/block cookies, you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device.

## **4. Cookie Sharing with Third Parties**

We use cookies set by a number of third-party providers to support website functionality, analytics, advertising and consent management. These third parties may share the data collected through their cookies with other organisations for purposes such as targeted advertising, performance optimisation and improving user experience. For more detailed information, please refer to their respective privacy policies.

We use Civic Cookie Control to manage user consent for cookies on our website. Civic Cookie Control sets a cookie to store your cookie preferences, ensuring that your choices are remembered for future visits and that cookies are only set in line with your consent.

Civic may also collect anonymised and aggregated information about consent choices (such as the percentage of users who accept or reject certain categories of cookies). This information is used solely to help us understand overall consent trends and improve our compliance with data protection requirements. No personally identifiable information is collected or shared as part of this process

Google provides several services on our website that may involve the use of cookies. These include Google Analytics, which collects data such as page views, session duration, and anonymised IP addresses to help us understand how users interact with our site.
